— How to use



As a cleaner:

- 1. Remove superficial dirt with a soft brush or sponge.
- 2. Pour a little quantity of product on a cloth.

As a stain remover:

- 3. Dampen a cloth or sponge with water and rub until the stain disappears.
- 4. In suede and nubuck, once dry, brush with the Tarrago De Luxe Suede and Nubuck brush.
